## Ken-Cliff Lanes Hall of Fame Selection Criteria

**Meritorious Service:** Open to any bowler who has worked for the betterment of the sport of bowling at the local, state or national level. Open to any bowler who has made outstanding contributions to the general good, spirit, reputation, progress and welfare of the sport through administrative or organizational work in any manner deemed meritorious. The number of years of service will be a consideration in the selection process.

**Superior Skill:** Open to any bowler who, through their competitive skills, has displayed outstanding ability and sportsmanship in the sport of bowling. The number of years of active participation will be a consideration in the selection process.

### Frequently Asked Questions

- (1) **Can I nominate more than one person?** Yes – please submit separate nomination forms for individuals. Couples can be nominated together, but please include separate information to the extent possible.
- (2) **Can I nominate a person or persons in both categories?** No – not in the same year. But we will accept their nominations for consideration in future years in the other category.
- (3) **Do the nominees have to be current residents of Carter County?** No, but please be aware that local nominees or those who have lived in & around Ardmore may receive more consideration during the selection process.
- (4) **Who will select the person(s) who will be inducted?** Your nomination(s) will be reviewed and considered by an independent Selection Committee appointed by the management of Ken-Cliff Lanes. This committee will remain private to avoid the possibility of any conflicts of interest, although we will be available to answer any questions the Committee may have about the general nature and intent of the awards and/or bowling-related questions.
- (5) **How will any requests for additional nominee information be handled?** Ken-Cliff Lanes is the liaison for the Selection Committee. In the event the Committee requests additional information we will contact you. If you have supplemental information, it must be received by the deadline to be included for review by the Selection Committee.
- (6) **How will the selected Inductees be notified?** Ken-Cliff Lanes will contact and make arrangements with the Inductees for their attendance before the ceremony so that they can be prepared with an acceptance speech.
- (7) **If I have questions or need more information who should I contact?** Please direct any questions to Ken-Cliff Lanes either by phone (580-224-2695), email (kenclifflanes@cableone.net) or in person.
- (8) **Will nominations be accepted after the deadline?** No – nominations **MUST BE** submitted or post-marked no later than November 19, 2020 for consideration in the current year. Nominations received or post-marked after November 19 will not be forwarded to the Selection Committee, but will be held for subsequent years.
- (9) **When will the Induction Ceremony be held?** Typically, it is held during regular league sessions in December. In the event of weather or other cancellation, the date may be set for another date in December or January. If your nominee is selected, you will be notified so you can make plans to attend.
